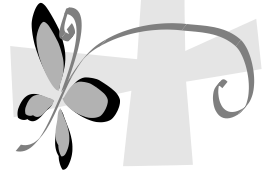

### Do You Have a School Bond?

The Holy Angels School Educational Foundation stopped issuing Bonds as of the 2012 school year.
