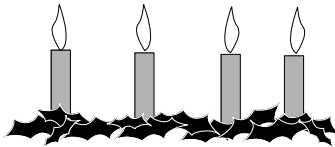

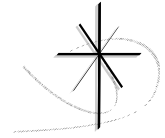
### Hearing Devices

## A Christmas Message from the Pastor



### Christmas, 2009

Dear Parishioners,

During this Advent and Christmas Season we welcome all of our parishioners and visitors who come to St. John-Holy Angels to celebrate Jesus Christ. During the Christmas Season we hear again proclaimed the so familiar passage from St. Luke's gospel about the birth of Jesus, Son of God. "She gave birth to her first born son and laid him in a manger. The angel of the Lord appeared to the shepherds as the glory of the Lord shone around them. Suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God."

This angel's announcement on the first Christmas is a summary of the entire Christian message in the Bible. It is not so much the message, "glory to God in the highest," but more so "do not be afraid for I announce to you a cause of great joy - a Savior has been born." At Christmas the family of the world converges around the birth of Jesus. God did not overwhelm the world with His power, nor with His might, but through the gentleness and delicate love of a child.

For us the Christmas celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ needs to replace the hectic pace of our lives, the distractions of our hearts and busyness of this Season. The details of the birth of Christ are a clear message for each of us. "She gave birth to her first-born son and laid him in a manger because there was no room for them in the place where travelers lodged."

When Jesus came to us He did not come where it was crowded and too busy for Him; where He didn't fit in; where there was no space for His birth among us. He came where there was room. He came where space was made for Him.

This Christmas, make room for the birth of Jesus Christ in your heart and in your life. He comes where there is room - whether comfortable or uncomfortable, whether pleasant or not, whether happy or sad, rich or poor, whether old or young; whether ready or not; whether your heart is overburdened or carefree, whether you are unprepared to celebrate or ready for Him with open arms.

Simply have some spare room for Jesus Christ, and heed the announcement of the angel: "Do not be afraid .....For a Savior has been born to you." Make room for Him this Christmas.

I wish each and every one of you God's Blessings and Merry Christmas.
