

This campaign will help us address St. John Church refurbishment, Holy Angels School windows, completion of Holy Angels Church construction, and Joan Muzzi Athletic Building renovation, and will also achieve the diocesan objectives to reinforce the pension plan for our dedicated employees, to grow the retirement fund for our beloved priests, and to strengthen existing diocesan ministries.
