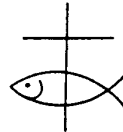

Days of Abstinence: All Fridays of Lent



Lent

To Fast means to eat only one full meal during that day. The other two meals should be smaller than the main meal. Also, no eating between meals. All persons ages 21 – 59 must fast on the required days.

To Abstain means to refrain from eating meat on the appointed day. All persons over the age of fourteen must abstain on required days.

PRIMERA LECTURA

Isaías 6:1-2, 3-8

Salmo responsorial

Salmo 71:38: “Delante de los ángeles tañaré para ti, Señor”

SEGUNDA LECTURA

1 Corintios 15: 1-11

+ Evangelio: Lucas 5: 1-11

El Evangelio que escuchamos hoy, se nos presentan dos cuadros. En el primero, Jesús desde la barca enseña a la muchedumbre que está a la orilla del lago (5:1-3); en el segundo cuadro, mar adentro, oímos la pesca milagrosa y sus consecuencias (5:4-11). Por primera vez en el Evangelio, Jesús enseña a la muchedumbre fuera de una sinagoga. San Lucas compone una especie de teatro natural, junto al lago. En la escena de la pesca milagrosa Jesús se nos muestra como un auténtico jefe o Señor. Jesús se revela a Simón y a sus compañeros en su palabra. Para las personas del mundo de Jesús y de Pedro, la palabra de una persona vale mucho, pues en ella se expresa su propia identidad, lo que es.
