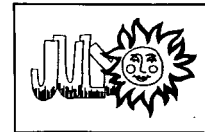

Visitors for Christ

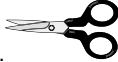
Visitors for Christ are men and women commissioned by the parish to serve and minister to the sick, the convalescing, the elderly and the homebound of our parish family.

Evangelio Mateo 10:37-42

El Evangelio de hoy, tiene dos partes. La primera habla del valor que representa unirse a Jesús, hacerse discípulo y la segunda la recompensa para el que hospeda a sus enviados. En la nueva alianza, seguir a Jesús es el culto nuevo, tan valioso como esa consagración sacerdotal de la antigua alianza.. Sólo que seguir a Jesús se hace con la cruz, no con la espada. El marco de estas enseñanzas es el de la alianza nueva en la Sangre de Cristo, en quien el discípulo encuentra vida.

La segunda parte se refiere a los discípulos sedentarios, o sea, aquéllos que hospedan y reciben a los cristianos itinerantes.
