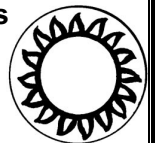

Holy Angels School Aftercare Program

The Aftercare Program at Holy Angels School provides after-school activities for students in grades Pre-K 3 through 8. The Program accepts job applications from persons from the age of 18 years that wish to work as counselors in the program. Among the range of counselor activities: supervise homework hour; develop and lead arts and crafts projects; organize indoor and outdoor games; coach performance arts such as singing and role playing.

Applicants must enjoy working with children in groups. Counselors are expected to take initiative to develop, organize, and implement new activities. Criminal background check is REQUIRED for all Counselors this check is good for 5 years. There is a fee which you would be responsible to pay.

Hours are 2:45 – 4:45 PM/ 2:45 – 5:15 PM/ 2:45 - 6:00 PM. Work schedule is flexible – you must be able to work a minimum of three (3) days per week. Wages are \$8.50 per hour.

XVIII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

I Lectura Eclesiastés 1:2; 2:21-23

Salmo Responsorial . Salmo 90 “Señor, tú has sido nuestro refugio de generación en generación?”.

II Lectura Colosenses 3: 1-5, 9-11

Evangelio Lucas 12: 13-21

Las lecturas de este domingo se enfocan en el deseo del hombre de acumular riquezas como su meta principal. Olvidandose que la vida y el futuro no nos pertenece, sino que depende completamente de Dios. Pensamientos egoístas sin pensar en los que le rodea, o que la vida se nos puede ser arrebatada sin previo aviso de manera inesperada.

En la lectura del Eclesiastés coloca al principio como que todo es una ilusión. El autor no quiere desanimar a los hombres, sino que dejen de endiosar lo que es simplemente creatura. Tras revisar los disrintos valores humanos y ver su fragilidad, llega a la limitación fundamental: LA MUERTE. Aquí caben las reflexiones de la liturgia, sobre lo paradójico y ambiguo del trabajo. El hombre trabaja para enriquecerse, para acumular riquezas, y allí se esconde un absurdo. El hombre se fatiga tremendamente por ir juntando bienes que él no va a gozar, sino que les dejará a otros. Nos hace ver también el esfuerzo desproporcional entre el esfuerzo empleado en adquirir bienes, la preocupación que exige y los resultados. No es cierto que el trabajo haga feliz al hombre, tampoco lo contrario, que haya felicidad sin trabajo
