Communion Services

October 14-17, 2014

On the days of October 14-17, our parish priests will be attending a diocesan retreat. The 8:00 AM Daily Mass at St. John Church will be replaced with a "Communion Service in the Absence of a Priest."

Communion consecrated by our priests will be distributed in a Liturgy of the Word celebration by trained lay presiders, with the approval of the Bishop and the Office of Worship of the Diocese of Wilmington. While the faithful have every right to receive Communion during Mass, in extraordinary circumstances, Communion is permitted to be distributed outside of Mass when priests are not available.

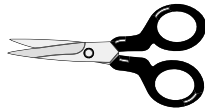
