Interested in Becoming an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Minister)?

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) are women, men and young adults who assist the priest each week with the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ. You must be 16 years of age or older, and a fully initiated Catholic in order to participate in this ministry. Participation requires attendance at a formation/training session conducted by the Diocese and yearly formation meetings at the parish.

Local (parish) training for all those wish to become an EMHC is scheduled at Holy Angels Church on October 11 at 7:00 PM, and also October 15 at 10:00 AM. Please note that you may not serve until you complete the Diocesan training/formation.

"Gospel of Mark" begins

We are taking on the Gospel of Mark! Most scholars believe that Mark's is the earliest Gospel. Mark's Gospel is recorded after the destruction of the temple and the end of the Jewish revolt against the Romans.

We cannot appreciate the Gospel of Mark unless we study the parallels Mark used; parallels and references to the Old Testament whose meanings were fully understood by the early Christian communities.

We will use the Little Rock Scripture Study program as our guide as we pray, reflect and share our understanding of the Gospel of Mark. Sessions begin October 9 and end on Sunday, Dec. 18. There is a \$20 fee for materials.

Save all your aluminum cans: soda, pet food, soup, tuna, canned vegetables, etc. The best way to check if it is aluminum is to hold a magnet to the can - if it does not stick, it's aluminum! Aluminum must be kept separate because it will go into a different container.

All other cans and scrap metal will be deposited into another container together. We will accept any metal items, including but not limited to: old lawnmowers (empty out gas/oil), washers, dryers, weights and weight benches, filing cabinets, metal desks, folding metal chairs, metal lawn furniture and tables (without glass), aluminum siding, all scrap metal, copper, iron, brass, steel, stainless steel, and even car batteries.

This is a no cost fundraiser!

All proceeds go toward new science equipment.
