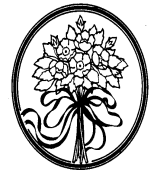

Would You Like to Dress a Priest?

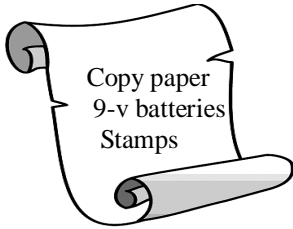

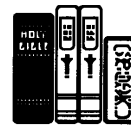
Religious Education Classes...
