Music for the Funeral Liturgy

"Lord, for your faithful people life is changed, not ended. When the body of our earthly dwelling lies in death, we gain an everlasting dwelling place in heaven." As Christians, we believe that death is a transition, not an end. We believe that Jesus Christ rose from the dead. We believe that by dying he destroyed our death, and through his rising, he restored our life.

"Music is integral to the funeral rites. It has the power to console and uplift the mourners and to strengthen the unity of the [gathered] Assembly in faith and love." (Order of Christian Funerals, §30)
