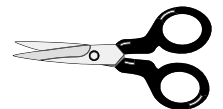

Primera Lectura: Job 7:1-4, 6-7

Salmo Responsorial: 146:1-6

“El justo brilla en las tinieblas como un luz”.

Segunda lectura: I Corintios 9:16-19, 22-23

Evangelio: Marcos 1:29-39

En la primera lectura la figura de Job nos invita a no pensar en Dios de acuerdo a la lógica Humana, sino a confiarse en su designio y finalidad.

En la segunda lectura, Pablo se ofrece como ejemplo al que se puede seguir e imitar. La Comunidad corintia le exigía dar ese paso. Apunta ya la relación que hay entre libertad Y caridad. En el Evangelio, vemos que el reino de Dios trae buena noticias para los más necesitados. Pensemos en la suegra de Simón. Ella está postrada y no pudo asistir a la sinagoga, a beneficiarse de la enseñanza y poder liberador del Santo de Dios. Jesús llega hasta donde ella vive la casa es de Simón. le toma la mano para levantarla y la sana. El gesto de Jesús está cargado de simbolismos: rompe el aislamiento de aquella mujer y la levanta. (El mismo gesto empleado para hablar de la resurrección). El grupo discipular aprende de su maestro y tiene que repetir lo que él hace.

- ¿A quién nosotros hemos levantado?
- ¿He estado atento a las necesidades de Mi prójimo?
- ¿Cuál es la misión que Dios me ha encargado? Personal, familiar, comunitaria?
