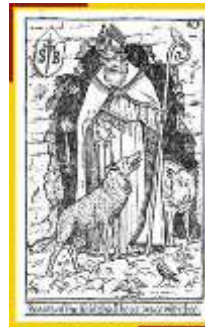

St. John-Holy Angels has joined the Newark Empowerment Center, a collaborative ministry of Newark area churches, to help the homeless and displaced in Newark, especially during the winter months, with Code Purple at Holy Family Church.

When the temperatures drop to 20 degrees or lower, area churches open their sanctuaries as a haven from the cold. This is not a shelter; there are no showers or lockers. It is simply a warm, safe room where people with no place to go that night can get in out of the cold. It is open from 6:00 PM at night to 6:00 AM in the morning. The host church provides a light supper in the evening, hot beverages through the night, and the Newark Empowerment Center provides transportation for those who need it in the morning.

Volunteers are needed to help at Holy Family Church when it hosts Code Purple.
