

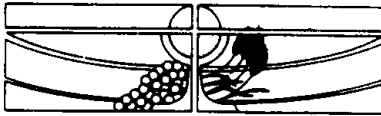

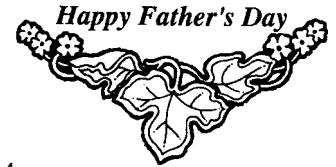

### 2015 Annual Catholic Appeal



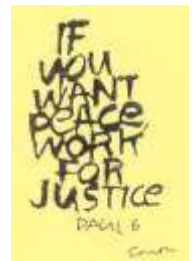
Thank you to everyone who made a pledge to the Diocesan Annual Catholic Appeal this Spring. The gifts and pledges we have received to date are as follows:

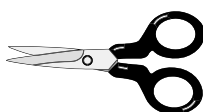

En la barca que sirvió de cátedra para la enseñanza de Jesús el grupo de discípulos se dispone a cruzar a la otra orilla del lago, por indicación del propio Maestro.

Los discípulos deben sentirse seguros, no inútiles pues tienen consigo a Jesús. La semilla sembrada no ha germinado todavía. Luego de que Jesús somete al mar, un gran temor se apodera de ellos. Es algo distinto al miedo a perecer. Ellos han contemplado que Jesús es más poderoso que el mar. ¿Quién será éste? Esta pregunta todo discípulo de Jesús la tiene que responder continuamente para vencer las adversidades y obstáculos de la vida:

***Jesús es el Señor.***
