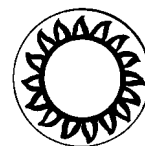

**Method I:** You may stop in at the Parish Center and purchase Gift Cards during office hours.

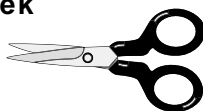
