## November



November is a quiet month for reflecting. The leaves have fallen, we prepare for winter, there is a calm (hopefully) before the busy Christmas season. The days are shorter, we will enter the waiting period of Advent, life is back into a routine, and Veterans Day reminds us how blessed and sad we are that others continue to die for our safety. We celebrate Thanksgiving and are grateful for so many blessings.

In the Church, November begins with celebrating the "dead". We publicly recognize those Saints the Church has given us to follow. We also remember others who have died, because we know in our hearts that they are also saints – though not officially recognized outside of our homes and hearts. We pause to remember so that we won't forget.

The Solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed celebrate this reality of our connection. As Catholics, we believe in something called the "Communion of Saints", which basically means that all of us daughters and sons of God, both living on earth and living in the final life, are connected – probably more closely than we realize. We can interact with one another in ways that are mysterious but extremely real.

In our parish, we will remember the "dead" who are truly alive in our hearts and in heaven. Each of our worship sites has a beautiful display of the Book of the Dead next to the Paschal Candle which is lit at our baptism and at our funeral and celebrated in grandeur at the Easter Vigil when we are "reborn" in Easter light. At the end of each weekend liturgy during the month of November, until Advent, we will sing the "Song of Farewell" that is sung at funeral liturgies in which we recall all of those who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith. We remember those saints, known to us by the church as named Saints, and those in our hearts as the saints we have had the honor of knowing in our lifetimes.

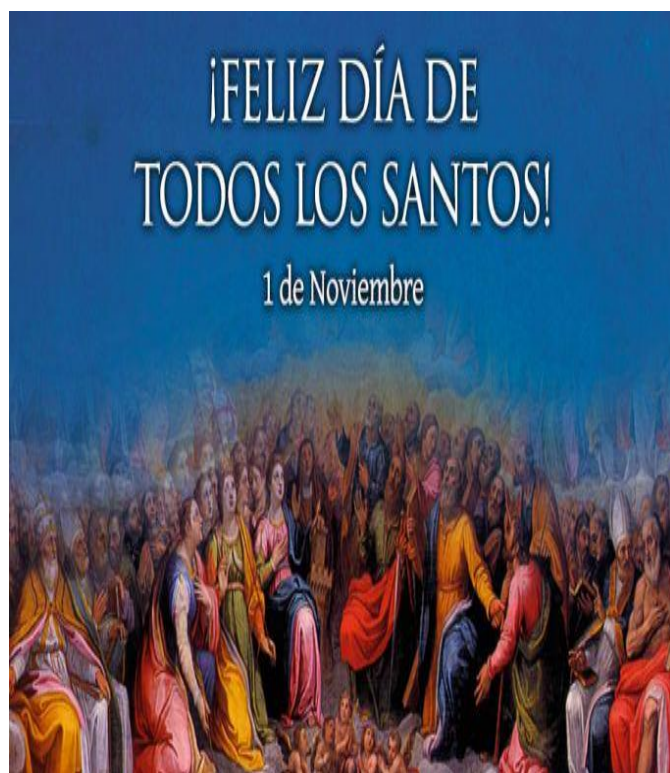
