What is Lectio Divina?

“There are many kinds of Christian meditation, but above all is listening to God through the scriptures, ruminating on the Word, a deep conversation of hearing and responding. In meditation we read not just for information; we probe, ponder, and explore so that the words of Scripture become for us the Word of God in our lives. ...

There is another level of meditative scripture reading: to ask, “What is it saying to me? Does the text have a ‘word’ for me in this day and time?”

These words from E. Glenn Hinson in *The Mind of Christ* express beautifully what happens when we meet for Lectio Divina. Using the 4 R’s of Read, Reflect, Respond, Rest, we focus on the Gospel Reading for the following Sunday. We meet at 7:00 PM at the Parish Center (PC3) on the second and fourth Wednesday nights of the month.

This is a Home & School Event and here is how you can help. Save all your aluminum cans, soda, pet food, soup, tuna, canned vegetables, etc. The best way to check if it is aluminum is to hold a magnet to the can – if it does not stick, its aluminum!

Aluminum must be kept separate because it will go into a different container.

All other cans and scrap metal will be deposited into another container together.

We will accept any metal items, including but not limited to: old lawnmowers (empty out gas/oil), washers, dryers, weights and weight benches, filing cabinets, metal desks, folding metal chairs, metal lawn furniture and tables without glass, aluminum siding, all scrap metal, cooper, iron, brass, steel stainless steel, and even car batteries.

Eligibility: 7th and 8th graders from Holy Angels School or Religious Education program or parish members in the 7th and 8th grade.

- Each entry must be the original work of the student for this contest only.
- An essay shall be no longer than 1000 words. May be handwritten or typed by the student.
- A poem shall be no longer than 40 lines. May be handwritten or typed by the student.
- A Poster must be sized to 11x17. (no paste -on please). It may include wordings, line drawings, and artwork.
- A video must be no more than 3 minutes in length.
- Each entry must have an attached standard index card containing name, address, phone contact, and school and parent name. Do not identify your name on the entry itself. Staple card face down so that name does not appear to the judges. Place video in envelope with your index card attached and face down. This system allows all entries to hide names.
- A student may submit entries for all categories but only one entry per category.
- Each entry must be submitted by 7PM October 31st, 2012 to the Parish Office.
